About the Venue:


- There are toilet facilities and water available at the venue.

Description of Classes:

(Judges will be able to provide a more detailed description at the show if required)

Agility 2 – Another go at a different agility course from the morning.

Clockwork Tunnels – A course that resembles a clock face.

Helter Skelter – The course will consist of increasing and decreasing circles.

Jump and Touch – First complete the jumping section with speed and then finish with your contacts and/or weaves.

Steeplechase – A straight forward flowing course with jumps and tunnels.

Take your Own Line - A Jumping or Agility course where the handler chooses the route.

Time Fault and Out – Keep going around an agility course until you make a mistake or run out of time.

Triple A – A course where the only piece of contact equipment used is the A-Frame of which you have to complete 3 times.

Tunnel Torment – You either avoid or take the tunnels depending on the judge.

Up and Under – A course with Jumps and tunnels.

	Dog Heights (UKA, BAA and KC Measurements accepted)		
Micro:	Micro: For dogs under 14" at the withers		
Small:	For dogs under 16" at the withers	35cm / 14"	
Medium:	For dogs over 14" and under 18" at the withers	45cm / 18"	
Standard:	For dogs over 17" and under 20" at the withers	55cm / 22"	
Large: For dogs over 17" at the withers		61cm / 26"	

Micro/Standard heights are optional.

If you compete at KC shows you can run your dog at their KC height if you prefer.

Dogs can be entered in classes one jump height lower than they are measured for if prefer – good for the heavier breeds.

Veterans/Anysize can run Micro, Small or Medium and there will be no weaves or seesaw in this class. The A-Frame and Dog walk will be lowered.

Starters dogs may carry a silent toy in the ring and will not be marked for refusals.

There is an overlap between Starters and intermediate for Grade 3 dogs, this is particularly aimed at new dogs starting to compete where their handler is a grade 3 at KC shows and the dog needs slightly easier courses.

Marking of Classes				
1.	Maximum course time 60 seconds.			
2.	Up contacts will not be marked.			
3.	In Starters Classes, refusals will not be marked except in the weaves. A silent toy may be carried in the ring during competition. (The toy must be kept in your hands and can only be given to the dog once the course has been completed. Please do not throw the toy in the ring)			
4.	In Veteran/Anysize classes the dog walk and A-frame will be lowered and there will be no Seesaw or weaves. Results will be split into separate classes if entries suffice.			
5.	There will be no tyre/hoop obstacle used in any class.			
6.	Both rings will be surrounded by netting and a space between both. Windbreaks will also be in place as an extra barrier between the two rings.			

Training / Running NFC:

- Training is permitted in the ring but your run will be classed as NFC.
- If you are running NFC please do not use food in the ring and if using a toy do not throw it in the ring.
- NFC runs must not exceed the maximum course time (60 seconds).
- NFC handlers can choose to run dogs at a lower height if prefer.

Rosettes:

- Rosettes to a minimum 3rd place in classes of 5 or more (Please note this number is based on pay before the day entries.
- Heights will be split when entries permit.
- Dependent on entry levels, some levels may be combined for awards.
- Clear round rosettes available for all classes

Trophies/Prizes:

Will be at our discretion depending on entries.

Winter League:

We will be running a winter league this year and winners of each level (Combined Jumping and Agility) will win a lovely prize and special rosette which will be presented at the end of the show on 30th March 2014.

Points for Leagues:-

The top 10 dogs competing at these shows will gain points for the classes they are placed in e.g. 1st place gains 10 points, 2nd place gains 9 points, 3rd place gains 8 points and so on. All results from these shows & updated league tables will be available online at www.ras-online.co.uk. There will be 4 leagues as follows:

- Starters
- Intermediate
- Advanced
- Veterans/Anysize (may be split depending on entries)

Progression:

If you compete at KC shows and you move up a grade during the season and wish to move up at our shows, please enter the equivalent level on our entry forms but please note, once you have moved up you will not be able to go back.

Show Information and Running Orders:

- A confirmation text or email will be sent to confirm receipt of your entries.
- If requested and paid for running orders will be posted out to your address.
- Show information, running orders and ring plans will be available to download 7 days before the show date from Alison's Website www.ras-online.co.uk.

Any queries must be resolved with Alison Schofield at RAS prior to the show.

	Agillidogz Rules				
1.	All competitors enter at their own risk.				
2.	Dogs must be over 18 calendar months to compete at Agillidogz shows.				
3.	We reserve the right to measure any dogs entered at Agillidogz shows. We accept KC measurements and UKA measurements.				
4.	We reserve the right to refuse entries.				
5.	If the show is oversubscribed entries will be limited.				
6.	We reserve the right to combine/split classes depending on entries.				
7.	All competitors when entering the show agree to help with ring party duties as enables us to keep the show running smoothly.				
8.	Anybody caught harsh handling their dog whilst at the show will be asked to leave.				
9.	Dogs must be kept under control, and on a lead, except when competing or within the exercise area.				
10.	Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead whilst competing. A flat close fitting leather or webbing collar is permitted. No tags please.				
11.	No food to be taken into the rings either in your hand or pocket.				
12.	When queuing please leave a sensible distance from other handlers/dogs and leave the entrance and exits clear at all times.				
13.	It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their classes on time.				
14.	Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date.				
15.	If the show has to be cancelled, Agillidogz reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.				
16.	Anyone found not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the venue.				
17.	Any dog that has been exposed to any infectious diseases or contagious disease during the 21 days leading up to the show must not be brought within the show boundaries.				
18.	Bitches in season must not be brought within the show boundaries.				
19.	The Judges decision is final.				
20.	Judges may run their own dogs when not judging.
