Classifications

Starters: For owners, handlers or dogs which have not won an Agility and/or a Jumping Class at a licensed Agility Test (Elementary excepted).

Novice: Open to dogs which have not won a total of two (2) first prizes, at least one of which must be gained in an Agility Class at a licensed Agility Test (Starters and Elementary excepted).

Open: Open to all.

Mini: Open to dog measuring 15 inches or under at the withers.

Midi: Open to dog measuring over 15 inches and 17 inches or under at the withers.

Dogs may be entered in only one type of Class i.e. Standard, Midi or Mini

Standard K.C. marking will apply.

Height of jumps:

Elementary: 24", Starters 30", Novice 30", Midi 20", Mini 15"

Awards

Trophies to third place in classes 1 to 6.

Trophies for first place in all other classes.

Rosettes to 10% of entry in all classes.

Clear round rosettes for all unplaced clear rounds.

Show Regulations

1. The Agility Test is held under rules of the K C Year Book as at 1st July 2004/2005 and H Regulations amended on 1st January 2005.
2. The entry fee is £2.20 per dog per class (£1.70 per class per dog for helping Cornwall/BAG members).
3. There will be no prize money on offer at this show.
4. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 7 days before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering any class.
5. A running order will be drawn for each class and will be displayed on the day of the show. No responsibility is accepted for competitors missing their turn and any one doing so may be disqualified.
6. Handlers working more than one dog in a Class must ensure that the dogs compete in the order in which they are drawn. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
7. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
8. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
9. The Committee of Cornwall Agility Club reserves to itself the right to refuse any entries.
10. Should a Judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge.
11. In unforeseen circumstances the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. In the case of cancellation of the event after entries close, organizational costs may be deducted from entry fees.
12. A dog must, at the time of entry for the competition, be registered as required by the Kennel Club Rules and Regulations in the Competitors' name (or registration or transfer applied for). In the case of a partnership the full name of every partner must be given. In the case of dogs recorded as owned by a limited company, the directors and the Secretary of the limited company will jointly be considered as the competitor for the purpose of the Regulations. A dog acquired subsequent to entry having been made at a Competition may compete as the new owners property provided that an application for the transfer has been forwarded to the Kennel Club before the Competition and the new owner has undertaken to abide by the Regulations and conditions of the original entry form.
13. A separate application for entry must be made by each owner and acceptance of the entry declaration must be given in writing in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entries cannot be accepted without the appropriate fees or acceptance of the entry form.
14. Judges at an Agility Test may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Test at which they are judging.
15. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Test if it is:
 - A bitch which is in season.
 - Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.
 - Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

16. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except a registered guide dog for the blind or a hearing dog for the deaf or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.
17. Not For Competition (NFC) entries will be accepted for dogs' aged four calendar months and over. Details of such dogs must be recorded on the entry form and they must be Kennel Club registered – there is no entry fee for NFC dogs.
18. Dogs under 18 months of age on the day of competition are not eligible for entry for competition at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Tests.
19. Please note that mini and midi dogs who do not yet possess a signed Kennel Club agility record book **may** be measured at the judges' discretion and if found to be oversized for their class, will be subsequently **disqualified**. Dogs entered in mini and midi classes who have not competed before 2005 cannot enter shows until measured and may be asked to provide proof of measurement.
20. Cornwall Agility Club and Blackdown Agility Group cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.
21. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
22. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
23. Dogs must not wear slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar, i.e. not attached by a ring.
24. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
25. No dog will be allowed in the ring at any time other than when being judged. No practising is allowed in the ring. A briefing will be held prior to the start of each class when competitors will be allowed to walk the course without their dogs. Prams and pushchairs are not permitted in the ring.
26. Any owner, exhibitor, handler or the person in charge of a dog is required to remove, as soon as possible, any fouling caused by their dog(s) within the venue including the car park, show approaches and exercise areas. Persons failing to remove fouling will be asked to leave the venue immediately.
27. Any owner, exhibitor, handler or the person in charge of a dog must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control within the venue and its environs including the car park, show approaches and exercise areas.
28. No monies will be refunded unless the show is cancelled.

Directions to Show Site.

At J23 on the M5, take A39 signposted to Glastonbury and Wells. After about one and a half miles, turn right at T-junction signposted Bridgwater. After about one mile look for left-hand turn signposted Chedzoy. Take this turning and club is almost immediately on your left. Show will be signed from motorway. Refreshments will be available at the show.
