### EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

1. Warm up jumps and exercise area will be available for competitors. No practice will be allowed on agility equipment in the competition ring prior to competition. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the show will lead to automatic disqualification.
2. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
3. Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter agility tests.
4. All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
5. It is the competitors responsibility to be available for their class.
6. No bitch in season to be present at show.
7. Mating of bitches within the precincts of show grounds is forbidden.
8. Dogs must be kept under proper control at all times.
9. Collars are not to be worn while competing in agility tests.
10. Food shall not be given or carried in the ring.
11. Handlers will be permitted to walk the agility courses before judging commences.
12. Any article carried by the handler is subject to the judges discretion, but must be indicated to the judge prior to the commencement of test.
13. **NO e-mail entries will be accepted. Entries will only be accepted when received on official entry form (or photocopy) complete with correct payment.**
14. **Each dog's registration number OR microchip number MUST be given on the entry form, otherwise the entry will be returned.**

**INTRODUCTORY** For owners, handlers or dogs who have not gained more than four first places in any Agility and/or Jumping class at a licensed Agility Test excluding Small Dogs. Max. jump height 18’’ (472mm), max. length long jump 30’’ (762mm). (*Note: dogs entered in Open Agility, Open Jumping, Interprovincial Team Agility or Team Jumping may NOT enter this class.*)

**PRELIMINARY** Confined to dogs (a) who have not won five first prizes in Preliminary Agility; (b) dogs who have not won three first prizes in Novice Agility; (c) who have not won two first prizes in Open Agility (except as set out in Small Dogs). Max. height of hurdles, table 24’’ (609.6mm), max length long jump 30’’ (762mm).

#### **SMALL DOGS:**

Confined to dogs measuring 15’’ (381mm) or under at the withers. The course should be compatible with the size and capabilities of the dogs competing. No hurdles or jumps shall exceed a maximum of 15’’ (381mm) in height and a maximum of 30’’ (762mm) in length with the exception of the Tyre, the aperture centre from the ground to be 20’’ (508mm), and the maximum spread of the Rising Spread Jump to be 15’’ (381mm). The Long Jump shall comprise two or three separate units, each unit a minimum width of 4’ (1.219m): the overall maximum length to be 30’’ (762mm): the height of the front unit to be 5’’ (127mm) and the height of the rear unit to be 9’’ (228.6mm). Small dog competitors may only enter Small Dogs, Introductory and Preliminary Agility (as eligible), and Novelty Event. For Small Dog Agility rosettes will be presented for 1st–4th places each day, but scores will be brought forward from Heat 1 to Heat 2, with the overall winner being announced at the end of the second day.

**NOVICE AGILITY** Confined to dogs who have not won five first prizes in Novice Agility or two first prizes in Open Agility. Max height hurdles, table 30’’ (762mm); max length long jump 42’’ (914.4mm).

**TEAM AGILITY/JUMPING:** Each team will consist of four dogs, with the three best scores to count. Competitors who wish to enter the team events should tick the relevant box(es) on the entry form. Nominated teams must be given to the Show Secretary on the morning of Sunday 5th June, other competitors will be assigned to a team drawn up at the discretion of the Show Secretary. Team competitors **MUST** be available for both days, as **NO SUBSTITUTIONS** will be permitted. Each dog may compete on one agility team and one jumping team, but no dog may compete on two different agility or jumping teams, nor may any dog run twice in the same competition.

**OPEN AGILITY** Open to all dogs, except as set out in Small Dog. Max height hurdles, table 30’’ (762mm); max length long jump 60’’ (1.524m). Rosettes will be presented for 1st–4th places each day, but scores will be brought forward from Heat 1 to Heat 2, with the overall winner being presented with the Victor Corbally Memorial Trophy.

**PREMIER AGILITY** Open to dogs who have won out of Novice and Preliminary Classes.

**OPEN JUMPING** Open to all dogs, except as set out in Small Dogs.

**NOVELTY EVENTS** Further details on the day. There will be two sections: one for dogs under 15’’ and one for dogs over 15’’.

*The Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute judge if circumstances prevent an appointed judge from fulfilling the appointment.*

**LUNCH BREAKS** may take place during competitions.

**A group of competitors will be asked to participate in a display in the main arena during the day.**
