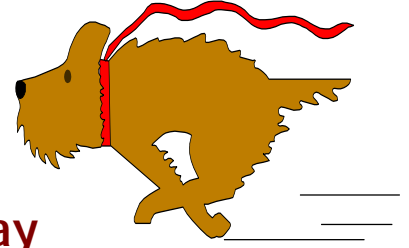

### Brace (Large Dogs):

This will be a standard Agility type course, where a Single Handler runs two different large dogs around the same course consecutively. The start and finish obstacles will be arranged so that they are close together. A single helper will be allowed to hold one dog whilst the handler is running the other.

### Brace (Small and Medium Dogs):

This will be a standard Agility type course, where a Single Handler runs two different dogs around the same course consecutively. The two dogs can comprise of any combination of Small or Medium. All obstacles will be at the height for Small Dogs. The start and finish obstacles will be arranged so that they are close together. A single helper will be allowed to hold one dog whilst the handler is running the other.

### Anysize Jumping:

Only open to dogs that are not entered into any other class at this show. This class is intended for older dogs, younger/inexperienced dogs, or dogs returning to Agility after injury or ill-health. There will be no tyre, or weaves. Handlers will have a choice of which height of jump they run their dog at (25cm, 35cm or 45cm) irrespective of the size of their dog.

### Pot Pourri Pairs: (Mix'n'Match Agility / Jumping Boxed Pairs)

All obstacles will be at the height for Small Dogs. A Pair can comprise of any combination of dog sizes.

The Agility dog goes first and runs the Agility course until either a clear round is completed or a fault is made. If a fault is incurred a whistle will sound and the dog and handler must return to the box. After a baton change, the Jumping dog does the Jumping course, again returning to the box after a clear round, or when a mistake is made. Both dogs run alternately on their respective half of the course until the course time is up which will be signaled by three blasts of the whistle. When the whistle blows for the end of time, you may complete the obstacle you are on and it will count towards your final score. At the end of the course time, the dog on the course returns to the box and the winners will be the pair who have completed the most jumps in the fastest time.

While one dog is working, the other must remain in the box but need not be in a sit or a down. The baton must pass hand to hand and a faulty change will mean five seconds added to the final time. After each change-over each dog starts at the first jump on their half of the course. Obstacles completed when returning to the box will not be faulted but will not count either.

Standard rules will apply so no tit-bits, toys, or bum-bags in the ring, and no swearing at your dog, your partner or the Judge.

If you would like to enter a dog in this class but do not have a pairs partner, tick the "Please Find Me A Partner" box on the Pairs Entry Form and we will allocate you a pair with someone else who is in the same situation. Not only will your dog get an extra run, but hopefully you will also make a new friend !!!!!

### Practice Ring:

A Practice Ring will be available all day for dogs entered in any of the classes available, and to any dog registered on the handlers Entry Form as NFC providing the dog is over 15 months old on the day of the show, and in regular agility training.

*Remember - Agility Is Fun !!!!*

*All Handlers Should Smile, and All Dogs Should Wag Their Tails.*

## Classifications

- Grade 1: For Owners, Handlers or Dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or 3 x First Places in Jumping Classes, at ANY Agility Show. *(N.B. Owners, Handlers, or Dogs, previously qualified out of "Elementary" are not eligible for this Grade).*
- Grade 2: For Owners, Handlers or Dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 as described above, but have not gained a First Place in a Grade 2 Agility Class, or 3 x First Places in Grade 2 Jumping Classes, at ANY Agility Show, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *(N.B. Owners, Handlers, or Dogs, previously qualified out of "Starters" are not eligible for this Grade).*
- Grade 3: Open to dogs who are not eligible for Grades 1 or 2, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2, and have not gained a First Place in a Grade 3/4/5/6 Agility Class or 3 x First Places in Grade 3/4/5/6 Jumping Classes at ANY Agility Show. *(N.B. Dogs previously qualified out of "Starters" are not eligible for this Grade).*
- Grade 4: Open to dogs which have gained a First Place in an Agility Class or 3 x First Places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 at ANY Agility Show, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3, and are not eligible for Grades 3, 5, 6, or 7. *(N.B. Dogs previously qualified out of "Novice" are not eligible for this Grade).*
- Grade 5: Open to dogs which have gained a First Place in an Agility Class or 3 x First Places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 at ANY Agility Show, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 4, and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 6, or 7.
- Grade 6: Open to dogs which have gained a First Place in an Agility Class or 3 x First Places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at ANY Agility Show, and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, or 7.
- Grade 7: Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 x First Places at Grade 6 at ANY Agility Show, two of which must have been gained in Agility and not Jumping Classes.
- Open: Open to all.

## Directions to the Venue:

### From The South:

Leave the M11 at Junction 8 (Bishops Stortford / Stansted Airport). Follow the signs for the A120 Westbound towards Bishops Stortford & Puckeridge. Continue straight over the first roundabout on the A120. At the next roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto the B1383 through Stansted Mountfitchet, Ugley, Quendon, and Newport.

After leaving Newport, at the roundabout turn right towards Saffron Walden. After entering Saffron Walden, turn right at the first mini roundabout, and go straight over the second mini roundabout, and follow the road into the town. At the traffic lights turn right into George Street, at the next mini roundabout bear right (straight on) and go past the police station on your left, keeping left, go straight across the traffic lights, and past Tesco's on your right hand side.

Leaving Saffron Walden, go up the twisty hill into Swards End. Go through the village, passing the water tower on your right hand side, and where the road bears round to the right by the village hall, do not bear right, but go straight on into Redgates Lane.

The entrance to our training venue is no more than 20 or 30 yards from this junction, take the track on the left by the yellow fire hydrant sign, past the mail box for The Crows Nest, and into our field.

### From The North:

Leave the M11 at Junction 10 (Duxford), or the A11 at Stumps Cross, and follow the signs to Saffron Walden. On reaching Saffron Walden, go past The Eight Bells, The Saffron Hotel, and The Cross Keys on your left hand side.

At the traffic lights turn left into George Street, at the next mini roundabout bear right (straight on) and go past the police station on your left, keeping left, go straight across the traffic lights, and past Tesco's on your right hand side.

Leaving Saffron Walden, go up the twisty hill into Swards End. Go through the village, passing the water tower on your right hand side, and where the road bears round to the right by the village hall, do not bear right, but go straight on into Redgates Lane.

The entrance to our training venue is no more than 20 or 30 yards from this junction, take the track on the left by the yellow fire hydrant sign, past the mail box for The Crows Nest, and into our field.

*Please Respect the 5mph Speed Limit along the track from Redgates Lane into our field,  
and take care over the speed humps along the track.*

## SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete but will be accepted as "Not For Competition".
2. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
3. No bitch in season is allowed to compete or should be brought onto the venue.
4. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time.
5. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
6. Should a Judge be unable to fulfil their appointment, Redgates reserves the right to appoint an alternative.
7. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges, or be in any way offensive to any member of a Ring Party or Show Organiser. Any person infringing this rule will be required to leave the show venue.
8. Jump obstacles heights will be: Large dogs 65cm, Medium dogs 45cm, Small dogs 35cm. (unless otherwise stated).
9. The height limit for dogs:
  - a. Large dogs - For dogs measuring over 43cm at the withers.
  - b. Medium dogs - For dogs measuring over 35cm and 43cm or under at the withers.
  - c. Small dogs - For dogs measuring 35cm or under at the withers.
10. Withdrawal of dogs from Competition - A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and not brought to the show / removed from the venue if it is:
  - a. A bitch which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious/contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any other person or animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
11. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 8 days before the date of closing of entries (17<sup>th</sup> July 2009) shall be counted when entering for any class.
12. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class and running order. If a handler is running more than one dog in any class, the dogs must compete in the sequence in which they are drawn.
13. Should circumstances so dictate, Redgates, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary.
14. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease:  
No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete or attend the event.
15. Food, Toys or other Training Aids shall not be carried, given to a dog, or used, in the ring.
16. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the competitor or their authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
17. Overpaid fees will not be refunded.
18. In the event of abandonment of the Show, Redgates will defray such expenses from the entry fees received to cover the cost of the Show preparation and any non-retrievable expenses before issuing refunds.
19. Any owner, exhibitor or handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) anywhere within the venue or the surrounding area and take it and any other rubbish home.
20. Our venue is a private site. The area around the bungalow, stables and outbuildings is out of bounds to all persons / dogs attending this Show.
21. Any dogs that show aggression to other dogs or to people may be asked to leave. Any handlers that show aggression towards any dog or other people will be asked to leave.
22. All dogs must be kept under close control at all times, and must be kept on the lead unless actually competing or when being exercised within the exercise area.
23. Redgates Agility Club has all appropriate insurances, and the safety of handlers & dogs will always be put first. However, by attending this Show, all handlers accept that Redgates Agility Club, the show organisers, and the owners of the training venue are not responsible for any injury, damage, or other loss, to persons, dogs, or property, howsoever caused.
24. Redgates reserves the right to refuse entries on any grounds, and also reserves the right to limit entries to the show to a maximum number of dogs in each ring.
25. Welfare Of Dogs: All Handlers / Owners of any Dog brought to the venue must take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dogs are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health or welfare at risk by any action, default, omission, or otherwise.
26. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk if left in a vehicle during hot weather or even on days considered as slightly warm. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle maybe made, without liability for any damage caused.
27. A Practice Ring will be available all day for dogs entered in any of the classes available, and to any dog registered as NFC providing they are over 15 months old on the day of the show, and in regular agility training.
28. It is a condition of entry to our show that all handlers agree to help for at least one hour on the day of the show.
