## **Basic Class description**

### **Time Fault And Out ( TFO)**

The Competitor must complete the course then continue until they are timed or faulted out

### **Tunnel Vision**

This is a course of jumps, tunnels and maybe weaves. All the tunnels are traps and must be avoided but a dog entering a tunnel is eliminated.

### **Helta Skelta**

This is a jumping course based on increasing or decreasing circles.

### **Power and Speed**

This is set in 2 sections, an agility section ( power )and a jumping section ( speed ), the power section is completed first and is not timed , then the speed section which is timed . Any fault in the power section equals an elimination

### **Lucky dip Jumping**

2 courses set in one ring, handlers has a lucky dip to choose which course they run

### **Up & Under**

A course comprising of jumps & tunnels only.

### **Knock out Jumping Championship**

This is 2 dogs running a straight forward jumping course with the winner going on to the next round. This will be a pay on the day class at £2.00 per dog, there will be trophies and rosettes to 2nd place in both classes. The top two dogs will qualify for the final. Dogs can only qualify once but can compete in as many heats as they wish , in the case of a qualified dog being in the qualifying places the next dog in the placings will qualify. All heats and final will be Class 1 open to all large dogs ( jumps set at 2ft) and Class 2 open to all mediums, minis and small dogs (jumps set at 9inch's).

### **Trophies and Rosettes**

Trophies or medals to 3rd in all classes

( 4th place trophies or medals may be given in large classes )

Rosettes to 20% of entries in all classes.

Clear round rosettes in all classes but must be collected at the show.

Elementary = Grade 1

Starters = Grade 2

Novice = Grades 3 and above

Veterans Classes are open to all dogs over the age of 7. Dogs may jump any height apart from large. Veterans may enter open classes at their chosen height. All sorts classes , this level is for dogs 15 months and over and has had sufficient training , or dogs who can't jump their own height for one reason or another or may not be old enough to enter veterans. Dogs may be entered into one ability level per show.

Large - Open to dogs measuring over 43cms at the withers - Jump heights will be 60cms (2ft)

Medium - Open to dogs measuring over 35cms and under 43cms at the withers

- Jump heights will be 45cms (1ft 6ins)

Mini - Open to dogs measuring over 27cms and under 35cms at the withers

- Jump heights will be 35cms (1ft 2ins)

Small - Open to dogs measuring under 27cms at the withers

- Jump heights will be 22.5 cms (9ins)

## **Leagues and points**

Your dog will automatically be entered into their own ability level league, we hold other leagues and should you wish your dog to join any of those (listed at shows) please write your name on the lists at all dogs on top shows.

Points for all levels (except all sorts classes where no points are gained)

1st..... 35 points

2nd.....33 points

3rd.....31 points

4th.....29 points

5th.....27 points

6th.....25 points

7th.....23 points

8th.....21 points

9th.....19 points

10th.....17 points

11th.....15 points

12th.....13 points

13th.....11 points

14th.....09 points

15th.....07 points

16th and over placings or unplaced clear rounds score 5 points.

Points are only gained on clear rounds .

No points will be earned for open classes, pairs or pay on the day classes.

Points accumulate towards the finals in August.

On Sunday 2nd May 2010 we will be holding a charity fun dog show , list of classes will be posted at the show along with further information regards this.

## **Dogs on Top Rules**

1. Dogs must be entered at their KC level not the handlers.

Grade one = Elementary

Grade two = Starters

Grade three and above = Novice plus

2. Entry fee's £2.30 per run

3. No monetary prizes are on offer

4. Dogs on top reserves the right to refuse entries.

5. Puppies under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible to compete, (except for 15 months to 18 months in the nursery classes)

6. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

7. No bitches in season are allowed to compete at Dogs on Top shows.

- 8.No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
10. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
11. KC Standard Marking Regulations will apply, unless judges specify otherwise in their briefings.
12. Withdrawal of dogs from Competition:-
- A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is
- a. A bitch which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious/contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any other person or animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
- 13.. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their class.
- 14.. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease:-
- No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete.
15. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring, a toy may be carried in Elementary classes.
16. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
17. Entries will only be accepted with payment by cheque, postal order or cash in £ sterling.
18. Dogs may only be entered into one height classification for any one show.
19. All dogs are entered at their owners' risk. Whilst every care will be taken, Dogs on Top will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury to persons, dogs or property.
20. All competitors must sign the declaration on the entry form.
21. In the unlikely event that and of these shows are cancelled Dogs on Top reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.
22. It is so difficult to find any suitable venues so please respect ours and clean up after your dog and dispose of all rubbish in the bins provided.
23. The amount of show rings will depend on entries.
24. Dogs on top reserves the right to split or combine any class due to entry size.
25. Electronic timing will be used if entries sufficient and hired from Taryntimers

### **Directions**

Leave the M1 at junction 21, then at roundabout take the 1st exit onto the A5460 .At the next roundabout take the 4<sup>rd</sup> exit , at the next roundabout take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit, drive along the dual carriage way over traffic lights till it becomes single carriage way then you will come to pork pie roundabout here you need to take the 5<sup>th</sup> exit , drive along straight over a mini island then turn left at next mini island , drive along and the venue is a little way down on the left it is set back in between houses.
