Class Definitions

Small: Open to dogs that are measuring 35cm and under at the shoulder. Height of jumps – 35cm

Medium: Open to dogs that are measuring over 35cm and measuring 43cm or under at the shoulder. Height of jumps – 45cm

Large: Dogs that are measuring over 43cm at the shoulders. Height of jumps – 65cm.

Large Grades 1, 2: For owners, handlers or dogs which have not won an Agility and or Jumping class at a UK licensed Agility Test, Elementary excepted.
FCI equivalent Level 1 (France 1^{er} Degree).

Large Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7: Open to all, except dogs eligible for Grades 1, 2 at a UK licensed Agility Test.
FCI equivalent Level 2, 3 (France 2^{eme}, 3^{eme} Degree).

Large Collie: Only open to Border Collies, Working Sheepdogs and their crosses.

Large ABC: Anything But Collies. Open to any breed of dog and crossbreed except Border Collies, Working Sheepdogs and their crosses.

Pairs Jumping Classes:

Turn up and go system – enter the class then choose your partner on the day:

Class 17 - Large Pairs Jumping. Open to all large dogs.

Height of jumps – 65cm

Class 18 – Small/Medium Pairs Jumping. Any combination accepted of small and medium dogs. Height of jumps – 35cm

Any Size: - Open to dogs that are not entered in any of the above classes on the day. This class is aimed at veterans, dogs that are unable to jump full height etc.

Maximum height of jumps: Large dogs 45cm / Small/Medium dogs 25cm (no tyre or weaves)

JERSEY AGILITY DOG OF THE YEAR

There will be four finals split into:

1st Final - Small / 2nd Final - Medium / 3rd Final - Large Grades 1, 2 / 4th Final - Large Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

A dog must be entered in all 4 qualifying classes to be considered for the finals. Qualifying classes are:

Small : 1, 13, 22, 31 / Medium: 2, 14, 21, 30

Large Grades 1 & 2 - 3, 15, 20, 29 /

Large Grades 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 - 4, 16, 19, 28

All scores count towards qualifying for the finals, which will take place on Monday 3rd May 2010 in the afternoon and each final will consist of an agility round.

Entry Fees - £2.50 per class



Prizes



Rosettes: Approximately 20% of entry.
Clear round rosettes in standard classes

Trophies: Novelty trophies for 1st place in all classes

Festival T-shirts / Sweatshirts / Caps etc.

Rules & Regulations



1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club of Jersey licensed Agility Shows must be registered with the Kennel Club of Jersey or Guernsey Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club of Jersey Regulations. The Registration Number/Non-Resident Activity Registration Number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry for all classes is £ 2.50 per dog.
3. No monetary prizes are on offer.
4. The Committee of Scallywags Dog Agility Club reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible to compete at Kennel Club of Jersey licensed Agility Shows.
6. Not For Competition entries are not accepted
7. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
8. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
10. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
12. All offers of sponsorship or donations should be recognised in the Schedule.
13. Kennel Club (UK) standard marking regulations apply.
14. The height limit for dogs.
 - a. Large Dogs - For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
 - b. Medium Dogs - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
 - c. Small Dogs - For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
 - d. Veteran/Allsorts /Any Size class height of jumps will be Large dogs 45cm / Small/Medium dogs 25cm (no tyre or weaves)
15. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership: or handle a dog at the Show on the day/s that they are judging; however, they may run their own dogs to establish a course time and check courses at the discretion of the Show organisers.
16. Withdrawal of dogs from competition: - A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the show if it is:
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
17. Where appropriate when estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days (6th April 2010) before the start of the competition shall be counted when entering for any class. In the event that a dog becomes legible for the next grade at a particular Show, after the entry for that Show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the Show Secretary at least 14 days before the date of the Show. The dog should then be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade.
18. Should circumstances so dictate, the Committee in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club of Jersey.
19. In the event that the Show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the Club will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped, self addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the Show date.
20. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
21. Separate entry forms must be completed by each competitor and must be signed by the competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
22. Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under the Kennel Club of Jersey Show Regulation 39 or Kennel Club (UK) Rule A42.
23. Animals in Event – Apart from dogs entered in the Show and 'Not For Competition Dogs', no animal shall be allowed within the precincts of the Show, without the permission of Scallywags Dog Agility Club.
24. All dogs registered / resident outside the Channel Islands must be issued with a Kennel Club of Jersey Non-Resident Activity Registration Number or be registered on the Kennel Club of Jersey Pedigree Register before entry to the Show can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club of Jersey Registration Number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
25. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits or at the discretion of the Show organisers.
26. A practise jump/ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the Show. This may be used at the discretion of the handler without liability to the Show organisers.
27. All dogs are entered at their owners risk and whilst taking every care the Show organisers/Committee/Club can not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury caused to the dog, persons or property whilst at the Show.
28. Welfare of Dogs – An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club of Jersey licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the States of Jersey Veterinary Surgeon under the Animal Welfare Law and/or the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club (UK) Rules and Regulations.

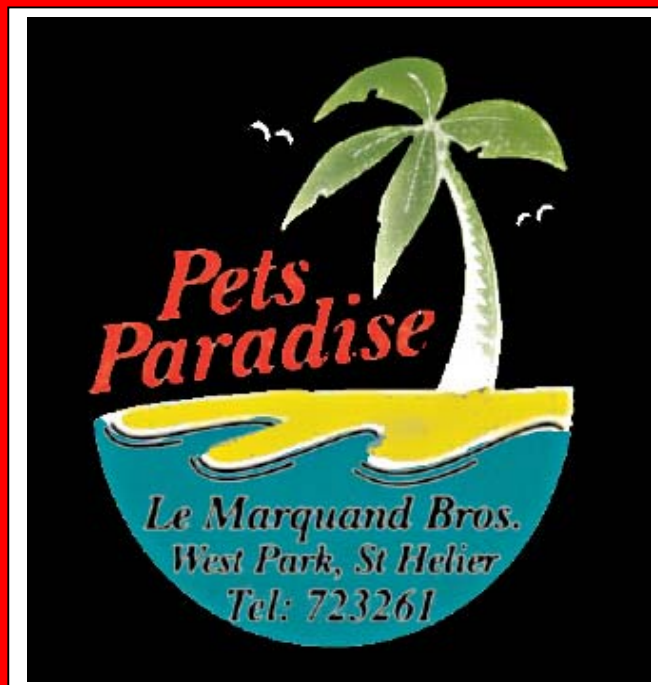
