**DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW – Postcode BA1 9BU**

**From the M4 motorway, the North, London, Wales and South West**

Turn south at Junction 18 on the A46 towards Bath. After passing through Pennsylvania turn right at roundabout towards Bristol on A420. Take first major left turning at top of hill signposted towards Hamswell. After about a mile, turn left at road junction and reach the top of the hill. Lansdown racecourse is a mile further on the right hand side. Drive round to the right of the main grandstand and over the racetrack to the camping and ring area. This route is the preferred route for caravans as it avoids the major hills.

**From the South** In Bath follow signs for Lansdown and Wick. The Racecourse is on the Northwest side of the town, about 3 miles from Bath centre up a long hill (Lansdown Road). The racecourse is on the left side after the Blaithwaite Arms at the top of the hill.

**From the East** Travelling along the A420 from Chippenham, pass straight over the A46 at the roundabout and follow subsequent directions as for travellers from the north and motorway.

## CLASSIFICATION for STANDARD CLASSES

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade) In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

<b>GRADE 1 (Elementary)</b>	For owners, handlers or dogs, which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows. <i>N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.</i>
<b>GRADE 2 (Starters)</b>	Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7, and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. <i>N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.</i>
<b>GRADE 3 (Graduate)</b>	Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.
<b>GRADE 4 (Novice)</b>	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.
<b>GRADE 5 (Intermediate)</b>	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.
<b>GRADE 6 (Senior)</b>	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.
<b>GRADE 7 (Advanced)</b>	Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Test. 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.
<b>ANY SIZE</b>	Open to any dog not entered in any other class on that day. Jumps will be 35 cm for Large dogs and 20cm for Medium/Small dogs, there will be no tyre, no weaves and the course must be flowing with no sharp twists/turns and no pull throughs.

### PRIZES

Rosettes will be given to at least 10% of the entry in all classes

Trophies will be for 1<sup>st</sup> place in all classes and for all grades within graded classes. Additional trophies will be presented subject to the size of entry within each class.

## CRUFTS Singles Agility Competition 2011 Rules



- 1 These competitions are scheduled as a Combined class for grades 6 and 7. There will be a separate qualifying competition at each height category
- 2 There will be 10 separate heats for each height category, (small, medium, large) held at Kennel Club licensed shows, throughout the country
- 3 The first 10 placed dogs in each heat will have the following points awarded:  
1<sup>st</sup> place = 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 9 points down to 10<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point.
- 4 Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat. Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the final
- 5 The 16 large dogs with the highest accumulation of points will be invited to compete in the CRUFTS Singles Large Agility Final at CRUFTS 2011. The 10 medium dogs with the highest accumulation of points will be invited to compete in the CRUFTS Singles Medium Agility Final at CRUFTS 2011. The 10 small dogs with the highest accumulation of points will be invited to compete in the CRUFTS Singles Small Agility Final at CRUFTS 2011



## CRUFTS Team Agility Competition 2011 Rules

- 1 This is an Agility competition and must include at least two items of contact equipment.
- 2 This is a team relay event and a suitable baton should be used which must remain behind the start line at all times. When the dog/handler returns to the start/finish, there will be a baton change between the handlers. No part of the next dog/handler must be over the start line at the change over; failure to observe this will incur a penalty of twenty faults.
- 3 These competitions will be scheduled as a combined class for grades 1 to 7 for all height categories. There will be a separate qualifying competition for each height category.
- 4 There will be up to eight separate heats for each height category, (small, medium, large) held at Kennel Club licensed shows, throughout the country.
- 5 The Show Secretary should record the top five placed teams and send the results to the Crufts Office at the Kennel Club within 14 days of the show. These results should include the name of the team, handlers, dogs and reserves.
- 6 Each team will consist of 4 dogs, with 4 handlers from the same height category.
- 7 The winners of each heat will be invited to Crufts 2011 to compete in the Small, Medium and Large Finals. In the event that the winning team or club in a heat has already qualified for the final then the highest placed unqualified team in that heat will be invited to the final at Crufts . Only dogs entered as a reserve at the qualifying event will be permitted to compete in the final should a change of dog be necessary.
- 8 This event is open to Kennel Club Registered Clubs with an interest in agility, all team members must be members of the club at the time of qualifying for the Crufts Teams Final.
- 9 Clubs may only qualify 1 (one) team in each height category for the final at Crufts 2011.
- 10 Once a handler or dog has run for a Kennel Club Registered Club in a Crufts Team Agility event they cannot run for another Kennel Club Registered Club in the Crufts Team Agility event at the same height category during the qualifying year.

## The Kennel Club Olympia Large Dog ABC Agility Stakes 2010/2011 Rules



- 1 This competition is a *special* agility competition open to all dogs excluding Border Collies, Working Sheepdogs and any of their crosses. In the event of dispute over the parentage of a dog, a decision will be left to the judge's discretion.
- 2 Those dogs eligible to compete in competition for Large Dogs are those measuring over 430mm (1 foot 5 inches) at the withers and open to dogs in grades 1 to 7 and judged under Kennel Club regulations for standard classes.
- 3 Competitors may enter more than one dog in a heat and may qualify more than one dog for the semi-finals. Handlers may only qualify one dog for the final, which will be the highest placed dog at the semi-final. Once a dog has qualified for the semi-final/final, further heats may be entered for competition although any placings in these further heats will not affect the dog's eligibility for the final/semi-finals.
- 4 The first four previously unqualified placed dogs will be invited from each heat to compete in the semi-final which will be held at the City of Birmingham Championship Dog Show at Stoneleigh. The first ten highest placed dogs at the semi-final will be invited to compete in the finals to be held at Olympia.

## SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1 Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/Authority to Compete number will be required for each entry.
- 2 Entry fee £2.50 - individual classes, £10.00 – Crufts Team events
- 3 Internet entries will be accepted via ISS at [www.ishowservices.com](http://www.ishowservices.com)
- 4 The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 5 Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.
- 6 Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
- 7 No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
- 8 No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
- 9 Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar ie. not attached by a ring.
- 10 Should a Judge be unable to fulfil their appointment to judge, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
- 11 No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
- 12 Classes 2 and 25, which are Large Dog Jumping for grades 1-2 are sponsored by Potato Crazy on both days. Crufts sponsors classes 1, 12, 17, 34, 40 and 46. Kennel Club Olympia sponsor class 24. There is no prize money in any class.
- 13 Kennel Club Standard marking Regulations will apply.
- 14 The jumps will be 65cm for large dog classes, 45cm for medium dog classes and 35cm for small dog classes. In Any Size classes Large dogs will jump at 35cm and Medium/Small dogs at 20cm.
- 15 The Height limit for dogs.
  - a Large Dogs - For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
  - b Medium Dogs - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers
  - c Small Dogs - For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers
- 16 Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging.
- 17 A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Test if it is
  - a A bitch which is in season.
  - b Suffering from any infectious/contagious disease
  - c Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any other person or animal.
  - e Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
- 18 In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition, i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010, shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. **In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show.** The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
- 19 Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
- 20 In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped, addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
- 21 Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to the dog in the ring
- 22 Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
- 23 No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period 21 days prior to the Show may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
- 24 No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
- 25 All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 26 A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
- 27 There is insufficient space at this show for a practice ring.
- 28 An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
- 29 All dogs are entered at their owners risk, whilst every care will be taken, Severnside DAC and Clifton A.C. will not accept responsibility for the loss, damage/injury to persons, dogs or property.
- 30 Competitors are asked to keep all children under control, especially near the rings.
- 31 Your attention is drawn to Kennel Club rule F8(A) regarding dog fouling. "Any owner, exhibitor or handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including the car and caravan parks and the show approaches".
- 32 Any bank charges resulting from cheques for entry fees being returned by the bank, will be the responsibility of the competitor concerned

## The Lansdown Summer Show 2010

This will be the sixth show to be held jointly by Clifton A.C. and Severnside D.A.C. at

### LANSDOWN RACECOURSE, NEAR BATH

Lansdown Racecourse is a large open area covering many acres and our show will be held in the middle of the racecourse area opposite the main grandstand. There is plenty of room to exercise your dogs. We now have the use of the whole of the area inside the racetrack. There will be 7 rings inside the central enclosure opposite the grandstand. Camping and parking will be in the area inside the racetrack. The camping fee is £16.00 for both the Friday and Saturday nights. *There is strictly no camping on Sunday night.*

### CAMPING

This year camping can only be booked by sending a cheque payable to "Severnside DAC" to

**Lansdown Show, 36 Hillside, Puriton, Somerset. TA7 8AN**

Camping will not be available via ISS. Please send separate cheques for camping and for your entries. Show entries can be made either using ISS or by post. Camping is restricted to a maximum of 250 units. Please indicate on the entry form if you wish your entry to be returned if camping is not available.

Camping within the enclosure will be restricted to Judges, officials and tradestands. All other campers will be positioned outside the enclosure in a specified area. Camping will be available for both Friday and Saturday nights from Friday afternoon after 1.00 pm. At the request of the racecourse authorities, there will be strictly no additional camping on the Sunday evening. Please include your camping fees with your entry. Only campers who have paid in advance will be allowed in the camping area. All units must display their camping pass. Units not displaying a camping pass will be asked to leave the site. No generators are allowed after 9.00 pm.

### OMNIPRO AGILITY FINAL

On Saturday evening after 6.00, the Omni Pro Agility Final will take place in Ring 4 and all are invited to watch. This is an agility competition for grade 1 and 2 dogs that have qualified at heats throughout the year.

Refreshments will be available during the day, but not in the evenings. No licensed bar facilities will be available, so bring your own. There is a pub, the Blaithwaite Arms, an easy walk from the camping area.

Electronic timing by TARYNTIMERS and equipment by ADAMS in all rings

### Fire regulations

Owing to the racecourse fire regulations, no barbecues are allowed in the camping area. All camping units must carry a fire extinguisher and have a bucket of water at the front of the unit at all times.

### DOG SAFETY IN HOT CARS
