AWARDS

- 🐾 Rosettes to 10% of entry in all classes except Classes 23, 24, 44 and 45
- 🐾 Trophies to 3rd place if 30 or more dogs in a class
- 🐾 Trophies to 2nd place if 20 to 30 dogs entered in a class
- 🐾 Trophies to 1st place if less than 20 dogs entered in a class
- 🐾 Clear Round Rosettes in all classes
- 🐾 Special Any Size and Special Veterans Jumping (Classes 23, 24, 44 and 45) – trophies to 3rd place, places to 6th plus clear round rosettes.

CLASS DEFINITIONS

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. A dog is only eligible for one grade. In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the three jumping wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1 (Elementary)

For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

Grade 2 (Starters)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.*

Grade 3 (Graduate)

Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4 (Novice)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5 (Intermediate)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6 (Senior)

Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7 (Advanced)

Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Tests, two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) classes.

Anysize

Open to all dogs who are not entered in any other class that day. Course will include jumps and rigid tunnels only (jump heights: Large and Medium dogs 350mm, Small dogs 250mm or less). One set of results for all heights.

Veterans

Open to all dogs aged nine years or over who are not entered in any other class that day. Course will include jumps and rigid tunnels only (jump heights: Large dogs 450mm, medium dogs 350mm, Small dogs 250mm or less). One set of results for all heights.

DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE

From Junction 23 on M5, follow signposts to Highbridge/Pawlett

Follow main road (A38), past Car Auctions on left and speed camera on right

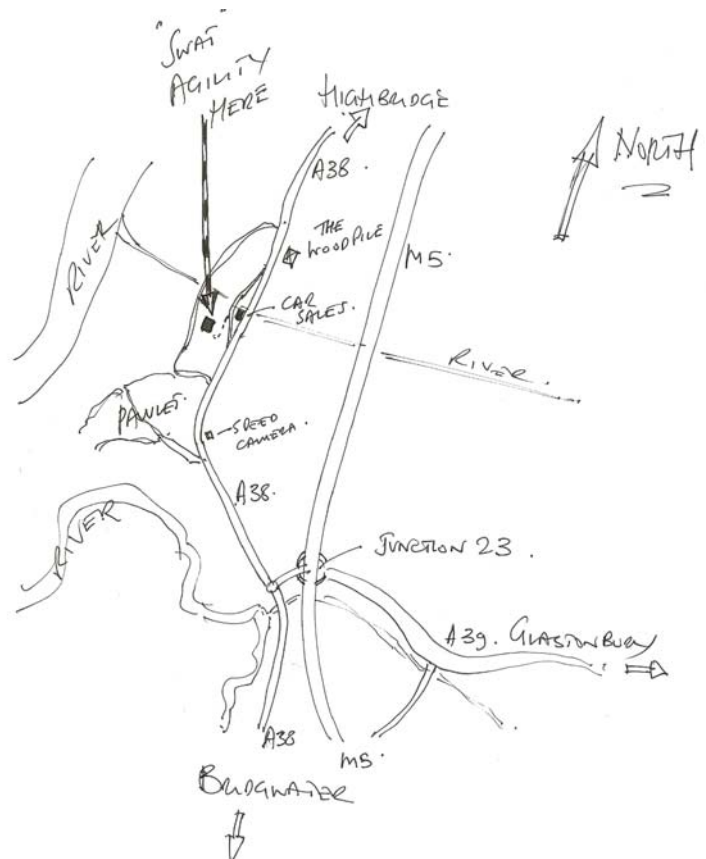
On outskirts of Pawlett, pass the sign for Stretcholt

Then, on left, there is a car sales garage with blue and yellow signage

TURN LEFT IMMEDIATELY BEFORE GARAGE (Old Pawlett Road)

About 50m along the narrow road there is a double gate on left – this is the entry to the venue

Please follow steward's directions and park accordingly



RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/Authority to Compete number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry fee is £2.60 per dog per class (£1.60 for helping SWAT members). No refunds will be given except in the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, in which case the club will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within one month of the show date.
3. There is no prize money.
4. The Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Puppies under eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
6. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
7. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
8. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
9. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
10. Should a Judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge.
11. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.

13. Kennel Club Standard Marking Regulations will apply.
14. Height limits for dogs:
 - (a) Large dogs are those measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers
 - (b) Medium dogs are those measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.7ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers
 - (c) Small dogs are those measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers
15. A Judge at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in his or her ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging.
16. **Withdrawal of dogs from competition:** A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:
 - (a) A bitch which is in season
 - (b) Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease
 - (c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent
 - (d) Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal
 - (e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing
17. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the first day of the competition (4 May 2010) shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes, a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to send notification to **SWAT c/o Agility Aid, 1 Mare Lane, Beenhams Heath, Shurlock Row, Reading, Berkshire RG10 0QH** or email agilityaid@o2.co.uk at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog should then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
18. Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them shall be reported to the Kennel Club.
19. **Animals in Event:** No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
20. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
21. **Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease:** No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42.
22. A practice ring may be available to dogs entered for competition at the show if space allows. This ring must be supervised by a responsible adult with agility knowledge.
23. A pay on the day class will be held if time permits.
24. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
25. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entries will only be accepted on official SWAT Entry Forms (or photocopies). Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees. Internet entries will be accepted via www.ishowservices.com.
26. If you fail to clean up after your dogs, you will be asked to leave the venue.
27. A briefing will be held prior to each class when competitors will be allowed to walk the course without their dogs.
28. No cycling will be permitted around the area of the rings when competitions are taking place.
29. No smoking will be permitted in or around any of the public tented areas at the show.
30. The duty of care for children under 16 remains with the parent(s) or other accompanying responsible adult(s) at all times.

Welfare of Dogs: An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

In case of cancellation of the show within seven days of the show date, notification will be sent to the relevant web sites where possible and notified to the iSS Show Hotline 07532 11 11 57. It will be the competitor's responsibility to check with the hotline and/or the web sites if continuation of the show is in doubt.

This form must be used by one person only (or partnership). Writing **MUST BE IN INK OR INDELIBLE PENCIL**. Use one line only for each dog. The name of the dog and all details as recorded with the Kennel Club must be given on this entry form. If an error is made, the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of The Kennel Club. All dogs must be REGISTERED at The Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Kennel Club. Dogs under 18 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. Not for competition (NFC) entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over, and that are KC registered or applied for. Any bank charges incurred through incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques will be passed on to the owner concerned. The Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC Number) for dogs resident outside of the UK must be stated or the entry will be returned. Only entries on this form or photocopies thereof will be accepted. Incorrect forms may be returned.
