## Classifications

- Grade 1: For Owners/Handlers or Dogs who have not gained a 1<sup>st</sup> place in an Agility class or three 1<sup>st</sup> places in Jumping Classes at an Agility Show.
- Grade 2: For Owners/Handlers or Dogs who are not eligible for Grade 1 and have not gained a 1<sup>st</sup> place in an Agility class or three 1<sup>st</sup> places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at an Agility Show.
- Grade 3: For Owners/Handlers or Dogs who are not eligible for Grades 1 or 2 and for dogs that are not eligible for Grades 4, 5, 6 or 7.
- Grade 4: For dogs that have gained a 1<sup>st</sup> place in an Agility class or three 1<sup>st</sup> places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 at an Agility Show and are not eligible for Grades 3, 5, 6 or 7.
- Grade 5: For dogs that have gained a 1<sup>st</sup> place in an Agility class or three 1<sup>st</sup> places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 at an Agility Show and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 6 or 7.
- Grade 6: For dogs that have gained a 1<sup>st</sup> place in an Agility Class or three 1<sup>st</sup> places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at an Agility Show and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.
- Grade 7: For dogs that have gained a minimum of four 1<sup>st</sup> places at Grade 6 at Agility Shows, two 1<sup>st</sup> places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.
- Allsorts: For 'old dogs, new dogs and don't fit anywhere else dogs'.  
Dogs entered in Allsorts classes may not enter any other classes.

## Rules & Regulations

1. All dogs entered for competition must have received appropriate training and be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner.
2. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete.
3. The management reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
4. Entry fees will be £2.50 per dog per class.
5. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
6. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
7. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
8. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
9. The Height limit for dogs:-
  - a. Large Dogs - For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
  - b. Medium Dogs - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
  - c. Small Dogs - For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
10. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the show if it is:-
  - a. A bitch which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
11. Should circumstances so dictate the management may alter arrangements as necessary.
12. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order.
13. No dog/s suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the show or which is suffering from a condition which adversely affects its health or welfare may compete.
14. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
15. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorized agent. Entry forms will not be accepted without the appropriate fees.
16. Any bank/postal charges incurred by the organisation as a result of competitors' actions or circumstances will be recovered from said competitor.
17. In the event of abandonment of the show, the management will defray any such expenses from received fees to cover the cost of the show preparation and any non-retrievable expenses before issuing refunds.
18. Any owner, exhibitor or handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog/s.
19. All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the management of the show will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.

GRADE CHANGES - All wins up to and including the 5<sup>th</sup> September 2010 shall be counted for this show.  
It is the competitor's responsibility to notify Red Dog Processing at [enquiries@reddogprocessing.com](mailto:enquiries@reddogprocessing.com) or by post, no later than 8<sup>th</sup> September 2010 if their dog/s grade needs to be changed.
