**This schedule provides all the information you need to make the most of your week's holiday with your dogs. It also includes all the rules and guidelines covering the week, which must be strictly adhered to so to make the most of a good time we suggest you read through it.**

**Security: ID bracelets will be issued on arrival Which Must Be Worn All Week  
Vehicle & Camping passes will be issued on arrival. These Must Be Displayed All Week**

These are for your safety and security. Replacement bands will be available from the Local Help station situated behind Trinity Rooms.

If you've got DOGS or CHILDREN then this bit's for you – which means it's for everybody.

Rule 39: People or dogs acting in an unreasonable/irresponsible manner will be removed from the show and forfeit all fees paid. All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult who will be held responsible for their conduct for the duration of the show.

No more than 2 dogs per handler off lead in the showground exercise area. PLEASE CLEAR UP after your dogs and place in the bins provided **on the showground**. If you knowingly don't, we will tell you to leave - it's as simple as that. So BAG IT & BIN IT!! The Woods & Common are CLEAR UP areas please **BAG IT & BIN IT** in the bins provided **on the showground**.

Please don't bring training equipment with you because we will not let you use it and you'll have carted all that weight around with you for nothing. Much better to use the space for another couple of bottles.

If you have children with you then they are your responsibility, and are assumed to be under your supervision at all times. Yes – even if they're 6ft tall and tower over you! This means you always know where they are and what they are doing. And if what they are doing is anti-social then we may ask you to leave. We may sympathise, but we don't condone. Parents, please advise your children on safety measures on site, with particular emphasis on road safety and bikes.

Remember the 5mph speed limit doesn't just refer to 4 wheels but 2 wheels as well (and anything else you can find to move about on)

**There will not be any measuring at the Show.**

And of course - THE RULES - you do of course read them avidly on every schedule you receive, but could we ask you to read **Rules 32** onwards again, just to make sure. These are particularly pertinent to the Dogs in Need show. All of the pages in this schedule relate to Rules and Regulations and must be adhered to. So this is a rule to read the Rules!

Due to restrictions placed on us by the local council there will be a reduced PA area, but for all your information and announcements Radio Dogs In Need will be broadcasting again this year, wavelength will be near to last years 86.6 FM and will be confirmed with your running orders. This will be during show hours for general announcements and 24 hours a day for emergencies.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licenced event should take all reasonable steps to ensure that the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dogs health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations

**Warning: Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.**

**If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.**

**Dogs In Need is a Private event and not open to the general public.**

## WHAT CAN I ENTER?

**YOUR DOG MAY ENTER ANY 2 INDIVIDUAL CLASSES PER DAY FOR WHICH YOUR DOG IS ELIGIBLE PLUS ANY ELIGIBLE PAIRS, HELPING HANDS & YKC CLASSES**

That's basically it. Your dog can only enter a **YKC** class providing the handler is a member of the YKC. Your dog can only enter **Helping Hands** if the handler does not run in any other class all week but helps at the show. You can only enter the **Fancy Dress Pairs** if you dress accordingly. Please note, the **Junior Classic** classes are included within the two-run limit, they are NOT extra classes.

## WHAT CAN'T I ENTER?

Just as easy -

**NOT MORE THAN 2 INDIVIDUAL CLASSES PER DAY FOR WHICH YOUR DOG IS ELIGIBLE!  
(with the exception of the above exceptions!)**

Now **everyone** has the same number of runs - how's that for fairness? As usual a dog may only be eligible for, and therefore gain points towards, one **Classic Final** - although they could enter classes for different **Classic** heats (eg an ABC jumping and a Graded Jumping) - so you must tell us which Classic you want to earn points for. Full Classic rules can be found on page 15.

## WHAT DO I GET IF I'M BRILLIANT?

Apart from the admiration of us lesser mortals, we will be awarding Trophies to 1<sup>st</sup> place in all classes, to second place if entries reach more than 30 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place for more than 50 with the exception of the Junior Classes where we will be awarding 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> trophies in all classes.

Rosettes to 10% in all classes. Clear Round Rosettes in all standard classes which must be collected at the ring as soon as you have got the necessary clear round. (Please also see rule 44) prizes will be awarded for Best Costumes in the Fancy Dress.

### Special Rosettes

Sue & Kim Taylor in memory of their English Springer Spaniel, Beckdale Jasper are sponsoring special rosettes to the highest placed gundog in the following classes:-

Large Dogs 1, 2, 3, 4, 16, 17, 51, 52, 53, 98, 99, 100, 101, 112, 113, 141, 142 & 143.

Medium Dogs 18, 19, 20, 21, 65, 66, 67, 68, 115, 116, 117, 156, 157, 158 & 159.

It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to notify the scoreboard if they have a gundog.

Think Black Leather & Lycra, Fish Nets.....  
Well the same as usual really!!**

## HOW DO I ENTER

You will need: 1 Header Form to cover all the entries and fees and NFC dogs  
Entry forms for your **COMPETING DOG(s)**  
Camping and Helpers Form  
Declaration for under 18's

- 1 Please complete just **ONE Header Form** to cover all the forms and money enclosed in your dog/class entry envelope.
- 2 Ensure you list all your **NFC** dogs on the Header Form and sign to accept the Declaration. They must be 4 months old or over, and registered or Name Applied For with the KC.
- 3 Complete an **Entry Form** for each competing dog. Enter ONE class number only in each box – writing tiny and squeezing 2 in wont let you enter more classes! Make sure you let us know which Classic you are competing for, especially if you have entered more than one type (say Grade 1-2 Jumping and ABC Jumping)
- 4 If you are entering a **Championship Class** then you also need to list your dogs qualifications for this class. You may opt out of having your address printed in the Championship Catalogue.
- 5 **Please** check the class restrictions carefully – we cant refund if you enter too many.
- 6 Complete the pairs section, if applicable. If the same pair is entered in more than one pairs class then you only need to enter it once and list the relevant class numbers in the box provided. Make sure your pairs partner is entered in the Show and not entered with another partner.
- 7 If your dog is only entering a pairs class or you are eligible for the Helping Hands invitation class you still need to complete an Entry Form so that they get a ring number, otherwise they will be assumed not to be entered for competition. Simply write "Pairs Only" or "Helping Hands Only" in the area provided for noting any change of handler – we'll know what you mean.
- 8 Complete a **Camping Form**, if applicable and a **Helpers Form (PLEASE) even if you're not camping** and an under 18's declaration form if applicable. Remember to tell us who you want to camp with and remember to tell the rest of your camping group to use the same name. If John Brown says he wants to camp with Joe Bloggs, and Joe Bloggs says he wants to camp with John Brown they will probably both end up very lonely. Indicate accordingly if you require electric hook up. Remember, it is your responsibility to provide a cable that is long enough to plug into the supply (minimum 25 mtrs). **IT WILL REQUIRE A STANDARD 13AMP - 3 PIN PLUG ON THE END.** Electric hook-up can only be supplied if pre-paid, and is 240v supply only. Electricity supply cannot be guaranteed and we recommend that you bring an alternative source of power with you as back-up. All entries, camping & electric applications must be made on the appropriate official entry forms and paid in full by close of entries. Please Note: Camping pitches are approximately 9m x 6m. If your unit plus any ATTACHED awning is over 9m in length remember to specify the length on the Camping Form in the box provided. If you pitch any other unit within your pitch area (eg tent, etc) there must be a minimum 3m gap left between units. These are fire regulations and **MUST BE ADHERED TO**. Any units not complying will be asked to move, so for your own sake please ensure you book enough pitches to accommodate your set-up. We cannot guarantee where any overflow camping will be sited. **Camping numbers are limited to 800** – helpers take preference if over subscribed. **IF YOU DO NOT WANT YOUR ENTRY PROCESSING IF CAMPING IS FULL THEN YOU MUST TICK THE BOX ON THE CAMPING FORM.** Rules 40, 46 and 50 also particularly apply, so to avoid any confusion here they are again:
  37. For the safety of dogs/people it is the responsibility of those using electric hook-ups and/or generators to provide adequate protection for cables and their own lead. People camping in groups who require electric will be sited nearest to the electric supply points.
  43. No camping units allowed on the Show ground before 9.00am Monday 16th August 2010. Early show helpers will be sent passes and must book in on arrival. **NO PASS – NO EARLY ENTRY.** Camping numbers are limited to 800 – helpers take preference if oversubscribed. The Show ground will be locked from 24.00hrs - 7.00 hrs each night. Camping units will be received Monday 16<sup>th</sup> – Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> between the hours of 9.00am – 8.00pm only.
  47. All camping roadways on site must be kept clear at all times. The erection of training equipment is forbidden.

Each year we need more than 500 'people days' in help. That's one day for 1 in 3 of you, half a day for 2 out of 3, but just a couple of hours if you would all help. If you can supply a complete ring party (12 people) then please state 'RING PARTY' on the form and list their names so we can camp you all together.

Gather all your papers together, grit your teeth and write your cheque(s). **Read Page 2 again**

- 9 Put all your forms in a C5 (A5) envelope, so you do the minimum amount of folding, we do the minimum amount of unravelling, and you pay normal postage. **REMEMBER – IF YOU USE A LARGE A4 ENVELOPE, OR FOLD IT ALL UP REALLY SMALL INTO A SMALL BUT FAT ENVELOPE, THEN THE POSTAGE IS HIGHER.** Underpayments not only cost a lot but will hold up your entry as we have to go and collect it. **Make sure you put the correct address on...**And finally-

**PLEASE DON'T STAPLE!!!**

## FINAL FINAL CHECK!!!

**JUNIORS** - are you eligible? Check the junior classifications carefully – Saturday's junior may be Tuesday's adult.

**PAIRS** - if somebody enters your dog in a pair and there is no individual entry form for that dog, or you have entered him NFC, then he will be deemed NOT TO HAVE ENTERED and we cannot subsequently put him in a pair. Remember, we are unable to accept half pairs.

Finally, please make sure you list all your NFC dogs you're bringing for a holiday - we'd hate to send them away with a stick attached to a tied spotty bag over their shoulder! Your NFC dogs should be listed on the Header Form and the declaration signed for them.

### AND IF IT'S STILL WRONG?....

Because of the volume of entries, we may make the following assumptions concerning incorrect entries:

**INCORRECT FEES:** under payment and we will chase you for the loot! Over payment, and thank you very much for your generous contribution. (well, it is for charity!). Bounced cheque or fees remaining underpaid? We will return your entry.....

**INCORRECT CLASS ENTRIES:** for dogs entered in more than the allowed classes, we will remove them from the highest grade non-special agility class, followed by the highest grade non-special jumping class. Championship classes will not be cancelled. **Juniors** entered as an addition to a dog's two entries will be removed from the junior entry. If your entry is sent in early enough when we're still in bouncy mood, we'll ring you first to check, but as closing date approaches – beware!

**Helping Hands** – This class will be a Free of Charge invitation jumping event on Saturday, for all sizes and all grades (so borrow a good un). Handlers must not have run a dog in any other class during the week and, of course, must have helped at the show during the week. This class is for those noble helpers who do the work without running a dog. If it was just for anyone who helps then it would have about 2000 dogs in it! (We hope!). For your invitation to run see the Show Manager or Show Secretary. Maximum 2 dogs per handler. See also page 5 item 7.

### RULES FOR THE AGILITY CLUB STARTERS CHALLENGE HEATS

- 1 Eligibility for the Agility Competitions will be as per the K C Regulations H for Grade 1 and Grade 2 in force at the time of the event.
- 2 The competition must be judged under the appropriate Kennel Club Regulations H in force at the time of the event. Competitors entering the competition will be deemed to have agreed to abide by these rules and regulations.
- 3 Competitors may enter more than one dog in a Heat, but may only qualify one dog for the Final. Each Heat is open to all eligible Grade 1 and Grade 2 dogs but only "Agility Club" members at the time of the Heat can qualify for the Final.
- 4 Qualifiers may enter further Heats for competition providing they are eligible. Handlers who gain a place in a Heat with a previously qualified dog should inform the show secretary on the day of the show of this fact.
- 5 The competition for the 2011 Finals will consist of a number of Heats, with the first 2 Agility Club members from each Heat going through to the Final.

### Rules for the OmniPro Annual Agility Starters Cup

Eligibility for competition is under the Kennel Club classification and is open to Large Dogs working grades 1 & 2.

The competition will be judged under the appropriate Kennel Club rules in force at the time of the event and competitors entering the competition will be deemed to have agreed to abide by those Rules & Regulations.

Competitors may qualify more than one dog for the final.

Each heat is open to all competitors eligible for Grades 1 & 2 Large Dogs

Qualifiers may enter further heats for competition, providing they are still eligible for Grades 1 & 2

Handlers who gain a place in a heat with a previously qualified dog should inform the OmniPro representative on the day of the show of this fact.

The competition will consist of approx'10 heats with the first 3 placed dogs from each heat going through to the final. In the event of someone qualifying more than once for the final, the next placed eligible dog will be taken from the appropriate heat.

Should someone be unable to attend the Final the next placed eligible dog may be invited at the Sponsors discretion.

Surrogate handlers will not be allowed.

# THE OMNIPRO & DINAS CLASSICS

## PLEASE READ THE RULES CAREFULLY!

- 1 The **OMNIPRO & DINAS Classics** will be in fifteen categories. Each Classic will have four qualifying classes, 2 agility and 2 jumping, for which points may be gained to qualify towards the Invitation Final.
- 2 **Dogs** may enter a maximum of any **two** Classic classes per day for which they are eligible, but may only qualify for one Final. If no Final has been nominated, and it is not clear which Final applies, then the Final may be assumed by us.
- 3 Points will be awarded according to any place achieved in each class of the nominated or assumed Classic, as per the official prize-giving for that class. Points will also be awarded for unplaced clear rounds. 1st place will receive 50 points, 2nd place 49 points, etc. down to the last place awarded. Unplaced clear rounds will receive 10 points.
- 4 The main handler on the entry form will be the handler listed in the posted league tables, and will be the handler invited to compete in the Finals. If this is not the correct handler, then the required handler must notify Agility Aid in writing prior to noon on the day before the relevant Final.
- 5 A full listing of dog/handler combinations achieving points will be displayed at the Show after the first 2 heats and again after the 4 heats. Those appearing in the final listing up to and including the designated lowest place will be invited to take part in the Finals on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> or Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2010. In addition, two white dogs will be invited by the show Manager. Only handlers who have not qualified as a Finalist for that Classic may run as a White Dog. The 2 white dogs invited for each Final will receive a commemorative rosette.
- 6 Invited finalists **MUST** book in the morning of their Classic at Ring 1's score tent by the designated time or they will not be allowed to run. Booking in for **Finalists** is achieved by completing a commentary card (supplied in the score tent) and posting it in the relevant box there. Full details will be supplied at the Show.
- 7 A list of invited Finalists will be displayed at the Show the evening of the last Classic heats for that Classic.
- 8 For the combined 1-2, 4-5 and 6-7 Finals there will be an equal percentage of dogs qualifying from each grade. The actual number to qualify in each final will be decided on completion of the four qualifying classes, and will be displayed at the Show.
- 9 There will be **NO** reserves called for the final.

## YKC Agility Dog of the Year Crufts 2011 Qualifying heat.

Open to **YKC Members** aged 6 and up to but not including their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, handling any KC Registered dog. Handlers ages as at the first day of Crufts 2011

First and second place in each section will qualify for the semi-finals at Crufts in the YKC ring. If less than 6 dogs are entered in a section then only the first placed dog will qualify.

Handlers may enter more than one dog, & may enter an already qualified dog - in the event of a second win, will be awarded the red rosette but the next placed dog will qualify.

Dogs may only be entered in one section and with one handler.

Only one dog per handler may compete in the Crufts Final. If a handler qualifies more than one dog he/she will decide the dog to run. The place will be offered to the next placed dog.

Handlers/Dogs placed 1st - 3rd in the semi-final will compete in the Final in the Crufts Main Arena, and the overall winner will be declared as the **YKC Agility Dog of the Year**.

Standard marking will apply, and jump heights will be appropriate for the size of the dog in accordance with H regulations in force at the time of competition.

The course will remain the same for all sections and will consist of an agility round.

## HEIGHT LIMITS FOR DOGS

Large Dogs	For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
Medium Dogs	For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and those measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
Small Dogs	For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.

**A dog may only compete at the height and grade for which they are eligible**

In accordance with Kennel Club Rules, all newly competing dogs must have been officially measured before competing at this show. Record books must be available for viewing at this show if requested.

**NB: There will be no measuring at this show.**

### DEFINITION OF CLASSES.

**Grade 1** For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.

**Grade 2** Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grades 1,3,4,5,6,7 and have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 (Starters) are not eligible for this class.

**The following dogs are also eligible for Grade 2 classes:-**

Dogs eligible to compete in Novice in the U.S.A, dogs eligible for Irish Kennel Club Preliminary class and dogs eligible to enter Grade 1 classes under F.C.I. rules (or equivalent).

**Grade 3** Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 4** Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

**The following dogs are also eligible for Grade 4 classes:-**

Dogs competing in Open or Excellent but do not hold a Championship Title in the U.S.A, dogs eligible for Irish Kennel Club Novice Class and dogs eligible to enter Grade 2 classes under F.C.I. rules (or equivalent).

**Grade 5** Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

**Grade 6** Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

**The following dogs are also eligible for Grade 6 Classes:-**

Dogs holding a Masters or Championship Title in the U.S.A, dogs eligible for Irish Kennel Club Premier classes and dogs eligible to enter Grade 3 classes under F.C.I. rules (or equivalent).

**Grade 7** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of 4 first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, 2 first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

**Championship Class** Open to dogs having qualified to compete in Grade 7. To consist of 2 qualifying rounds of Standard Kennel Club Classes, 1 Agility Class and 1 Jumping Class and a final round of Agility to be held at the same Show.

### SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. The registration number/authority to compete number will be required for each entry.
- 2 Entry fees: £2.80 per dog per class, £10.00 per Championship entry, £5.60 per pair. Camping £70.00, electric hook-up £40.00. Postage 60p (UK), £1.50p (Europe) £2.50 (Rest of the World). All entries, camping and electric are inclusive of VAT at the standard rate. If you require a VAT receipt please send an SAE marked 'VAT' with your entries.
- 3 No prize money will be paid.
- 4 Internet entries will be accepted via [www.iShowservices.com](http://www.iShowservices.com)
- 5 The Committee reserves itself the right to refuse entries.
- 6 Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible to compete at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows.
- 7 Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club Registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
- 8 No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
- 9 No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the show.
- 10 Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. Not attached by a ring.
- 11 Should a Judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge, the committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge.
- 12 No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
- 13 Sponsors are listed on the back page.
- 14 Kennel Club standard marking regulations will apply.
- 15 Height limit for dogs: Large Dogs – For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers, Medium Dogs – For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers. Small Dogs – For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75mm) or under at the withers.
- 16 Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership; or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging.
- 17 Withdrawal of dogs from Competition. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from the Show if it is
  - a. A bitch which is in season.
  - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
  - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
  - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
  - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

- 18 In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition, i.e. 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2010 shall be counted when entering for any class. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitors responsibility to notify the show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show. The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered in the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor should be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
- 19 Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
- 20 In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club/society will refund fees, less any reasonably incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
- 21 Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
- 22 Ballot for Championship Class Running Orders
- a. Agility Round and Jumping Round – A draw for the running order of the Agility and Jumping rounds will be made prior to the show. The relevant competitors will be notified before the day of the show. The dogs must run in the order in which they are drawn.
- b. Final Agility Round – Dogs to run in the reverse order to their combined placings at the end of the first two rounds.
- 23 Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
- 24 Competition of Dogs Suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A42
- 25 Animals at Event. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes, or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times
- 26 All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority To Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 27 A pay on the day class will be held if time permits. There will not be a practice ring. There will be a Junior Training ring.
- 28 Competitors are reminded of the suffering that can be caused when dogs are left in cars on sunny days. Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs found in a distressed condition.
- 29 All dogs will be entered at this Show at their owner's risk. Whilst the Committee and helpers will undertake every care, they will not take responsibility for loss, damage or injury howsoever caused to dogs, persons or property.
- 30 There will be no practising/training in the Ring during or after the Show.
- 31 The Competition Manager cannot enter or work a dog at the Show.
- 32 Please clear up after your dogs and place in bins provided. Anyone knowingly not doing so will be asked to leave the Venue and forfeit any remaining class entries.
- 33 Puppies under 4 calendar months of age are not permitted at the Show. This includes the Car Parks and Exercise areas.
- 34 Please do not leave your dogs loose when unattended, tethers should be a maximum of 2mtrs in length.
- 35 Speed limit on site is 5mph (KC recommendation) and will be strictly enforced. All drivers of vehicles on site must hold a full driving licence.
- 36 All caravans/camping units to carry suitable fire extinguishers and facilities for fire fighting and first aid. All vehicles/caravans/camping units must display passes at all times. Any found not doing so will be removed from the Showground. Fire points will be indicated by a solid red flag. Campers are asked not to fly red flags from their caravans.
- 37 For the safety of dogs/people it is the responsibility of those using electric hook-ups and/or generators to provide adequate protection for cables and their own lead. People camping in groups who require electric will be sited nearest to the electric supply points.
- 38 All people and dogs attending the Show will be bound by Dogs In Need Rules. All Trade Stand vendors must comply with the Rules and Regulations of this Show. Only those having paid for a trade stand will be allowed to trade at this show, any un-authorised traders will be immediately removed from the showground forfeiting any camping/entry fees.
- 39 People or dogs acting in an unreasonable/irresponsible manner will be removed from the Show and forfeit all fees paid. All under 18's must be accompanied by an adult who will be held responsible for their conduct for the duration of the Show.
- 40 Definition of Test Area - all rings.
- 41 Running orders MUST be adhered to (with the exception of bona fide workers or a note from teacher) unless you want to face not running.
- 42 A dog which is known to be unsociable and 'snappy' must be muzzled when in the vicinity of people or other dogs.
- 43 No camping units allowed on the Show ground before 9.00am Monday 11th August 2008. Early show helpers will be sent passes and must book in on arrival. NO PASS – NO EARLY ENTRY. Camping numbers are limited to 800 – helpers take preference if oversubscribed. The Show ground will be locked from 24.00hrs - 7.00 hrs each night. Camping units will be received Monday 11th – Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 9.00am to 8.00pm only.
- 44 Rosettes and awards must be collected at the Show. Rosettes & awards will not be issued before the official prize-giving. These usually start after lunch at approx. 2.00pm.
- 45 The owner, competitor, handler or any other person in charge of a dog at a Kennel Club licensed event must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car & caravan parks & approaches. All dogs must be kept on lead other than when in the test area and the designated exercise area where they must still be under control.
- 46 All fees must be paid in pounds sterling and drawn on a UK bank or postal order. No refunds will be given. All entries, camping & electric must be made on the appropriate official entry forms and **paid in full** by close of entries. Camping pitches & electric hook-ups are NOT TRANSFERABLE.
- 47 All camping roadways on site must be kept clear at all times. The erection of training equipment is forbidden.
- 48 Day parkers must park in the day parking area or be removed, and must display their ISS envelopes at all times. Disabled people with badges will be allowed to park in the disabled parking area.
- 49 All people at this show have a responsibility to take care of the health and safety of themselves and others, and to report any health and safety concerns to the Show Manager.
- 50 It is the responsibility of the handler to ensure that any change of handler is recorded on the scribe sheet prior to competing, otherwise the run will be declared NFC.
- 51 The Committee reserves the right to return any entries, without further notification, if fees remain unpaid, for whatever reason.
- 52 Digital or analogue recording within the precincts of the show for reward or gain will only be allowed by permission of the Show Manager.
- 53 Under section 2 of the Health Act 2006, smoking will not be permitted within any covered or enclosed public area, including score tents.
