Dogs entering the Allsorts/Anysize classes may not enter any other class.

GRADE CHANGES

Grade changes up to and including Sunday 26th February will count for this show, please inform the Show Secretary by Friday 2nd March should you need to change your dog's grade.

Awards

- 1st – for class entries 1-10
- 1st, 2nd – for class entries 1-20
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd – for class entries 20+

Placed Rosettes to at least 10% ~ Clear Round Rosettes in all classes

Allsorts/Anysize Classes:

No trophies or rosettes will be awarded in these classes,
Doggy treats will be available for each dog that runs instead.

Steeplechase: A simple flowing jumping course with no weaves.

Power & Speed: The power section is to be negotiated first and will consist of; contact equipment, weaves, spread jump and long jump. If this is completed without faults the handler then continues to the Speed Section, which is a short jumping course. The fastest Clear Round in the Speed Section is the winner.

Pairs Jumping: **Large Pairs:** will consist of two large dogs, jump heights will be 65cm.
Small/Medium Pairs: will consist of any combination of Small or Medium dog, jump heights for both dogs will be 35cm.

Allsorts Agility & Anysize Jumping: These classes are particularly suitable for inexperienced dogs or handlers, and those dogs that are unable to compete at their full height. Jump heights will be 45cm (medium), 35cm (small) and 20cm (micro). Dogs may jump whichever height suits them best, regardless of the dog's size, please state on your entry form which height you would like your dog to run at.
Anysize Jumping: will have no weaves, tyre, long jump or contact equipment.
Allsorts Agility: will have no weaves, tyre, long jump or see-saw, the A Frame and Dog Walk will be set at a lower height.

Classifications and Eligibility

All dogs must have received appropriate agility training, be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner and be registered with a recognised agility organisation

- Grade 1: For Owners/Handlers or Dogs who have not gained a 1st place in an Agility class or three 1st places in Jumping Classes at an Agility Show/s.
- Grade 2: For Owners/Handlers or Dogs who are not eligible for Grade 1 and have not gained a 1st place in an Agility class or three 1st places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at an Agility Show/s.
- Grade 3: For Owners/Handlers or Dogs who are not eligible for Grades 1 or 2 and for dogs that are not eligible for Grades 4, 5, 6 or 7.
- Grade 4: For dogs that have gained a 1st place in an Agility class or three 1st places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 at an Agility Show/s and are not eligible for Grades 3, 5, 6 or 7.
- Grade 5: For dogs that have gained a 1st place in an Agility class or three 1st places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 at an Agility Show/s and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 6 or 7.
- Grade 6: For dogs that have gained a 1st place in an Agility Class or three 1st places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at an Agility Show/s and are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.
- Grade 7: For dogs that have gained a minimum of four 1st places at Grade 6 at Agility Shows, two 1st places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Dogs entered at this show must have received appropriate agility training, be able to negotiate all equipment in a safe manner and be registered with a recognised agility organisation.
2. Entry fees £2.70 per dog per class.
3. JDA DTC reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
4. Dogs under 18 calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete.
5. Not For Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over.
6. No bitch in season is allowed to compete.
7. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time.
8. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
9. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.
10. Marking will be as per Standard Kennel Club rules.
11. Hurdle Heights: Large 650mm, Medium 450mm, Small 350mm, (unless otherwise stated).
12. The Height limit for dogs:-
 - a. Large Dogs - For dogs measuring over 430mm (1ft 5ins) at the withers.
 - b. Medium Dogs - For dogs measuring over 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) and measuring 430mm (1ft 5ins) or under at the withers.
 - c. Small Dogs - For dogs measuring 350mm (1ft 1.75ins) or under at the withers.
13. A dog shall be withdrawn from competition and removed from an Agility Show if it is:-
 - a. A bitch which is in season.
 - b. Suffering from any infectious diseases or contagious disease.
 - c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.
 - d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.
 - e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
14. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, JDA DTC will refund fees, less any incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within one calendar month of the day of the show.
15. Food shall not be carried in the hand or given to a dog in the ring.
16. Separate entry forms must be completed by each Competitor and must be signed by the Competitor or his authorized agent, entry forms must be accompanied with the appropriate fees.
17. Any bank/postal charges incurred by the organisation as a result of competitors' actions or circumstances will be recovered from said competitor.
18. No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete.
19. It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class and running order.
20. Any handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s); failure to do so may result in removal from the show.
21. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
22. All dogs are entered at this show at their owners risk and whilst every care will be taken, the management of the show will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the show.
23. JDA DTC reserves the right to limit or close entries before the published closing date if necessary.
